Please be advised of the following changes at St. Francis of Assisi:



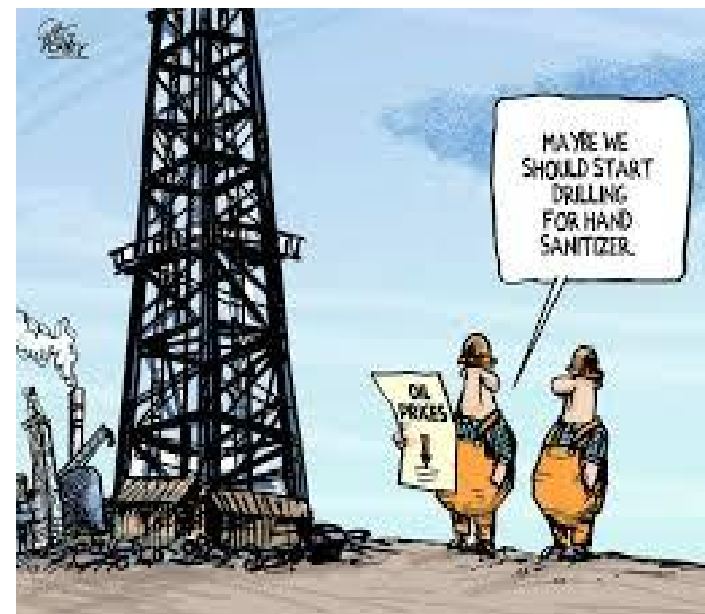
- Weekday Mass will continue to be celebrated every Wednesday and Thursday at 9:00am with a capacity of 10 (including Fr. John)
