We are pleased to announce the following update for St. Francis of Assisi Church:

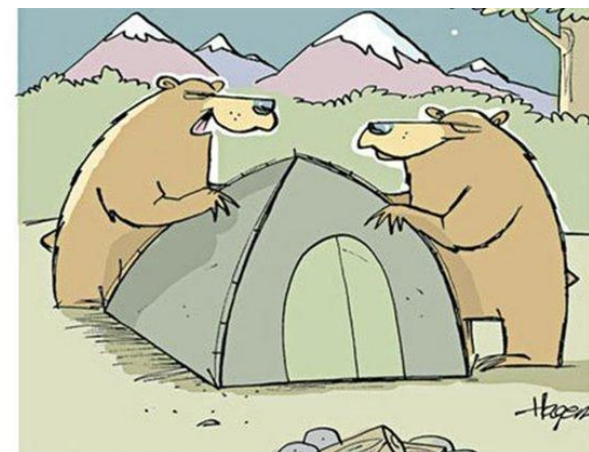

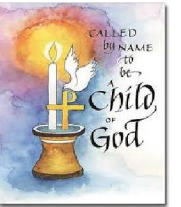
