St. Francis of Assisi Church:

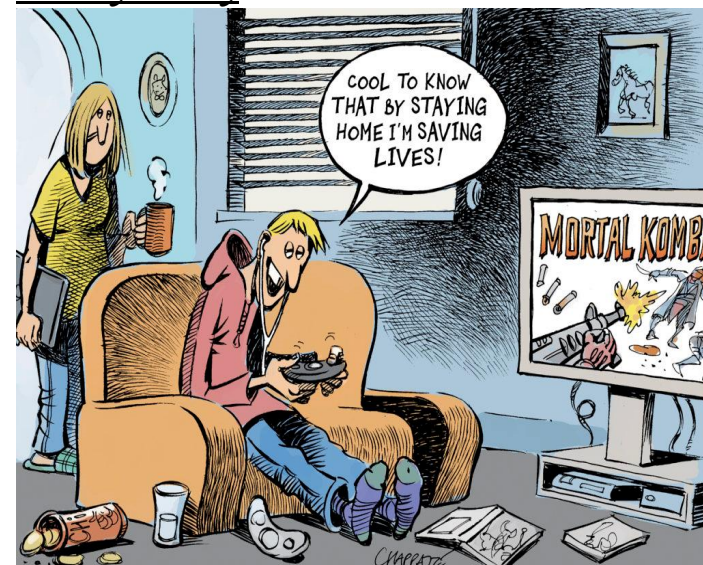
- There is no capacity limit for churches, however,

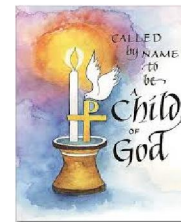

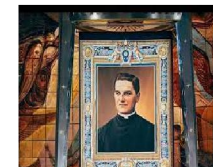
