



<u>Synod of Bishops - Survey</u>

Communion, Participation, and Mission Transforming Our Lives; Building Our Church

Pope Francis has announced that in preparation for the next Synod of Bishops, there will be a worldwide conversation in the Church or a "synod" about community, engaged participation, and the mission of evangelization. This conversation will follow a two-year path and involve the People of God - everyone, everywhere.

To open the conversations, the Diocesan Pastoral Planning Committee is launching a survey inviting the input of all the People of God. This input will be part of both the worldwide and local conversations to establish pastoral priorities within the Church.
