Covid-19 Update

Most Reverend Bishop Miehm has provided these guidelines after the announcement that Ontario will move to the next phase of reopening on February 17, 2022. All places of work will reopen for onsite work effective Tuesday, February 22, 2022.

The Vaccine Policy for the Diocese of Peterborough remains in effect at this time.

Capacity limits in churches are relatively unchanged noting the requirement to maintain 6 feet or 2 meters of distance between households remains in effect. Also, wearing a face mask is still required.

Parish Halls will remain closed for the time being.
