Covid-19 Update

Most Reverend Bishop Miehm has provided these guidelines after moving to the next phase of reopening. All places of work are now open for onsite work.

The Vaccine Policy for the Diocese of Peterborough remains in effect at this time.

Capacity limits in churches are relatively unchanged noting the requirement to maintain 6 feet or 2 meters of distance between households remains in effect. Also, wearing a face mask is still required.

Parish Halls will remain closed for the time being.
